Buck Taylor, a south Georgia native, has been looking at the world through a camera lens for over fifty years. He has hunted, fished and photographed from Africa to Alaska to Argentina, all the while having fun and recording memorable images.

Birds of the Flint River Watershed, consisting of 31 high-resolution digital images, represents some of Mr. Taylor's finest work. From the tiny Ruby-throated hummingbird to the mostly nocturnal Yellow-crowned night heron, visitors will come face to face with native birds, many of which are part of the RiverQuarium's new Cypress Pond Aviary. The exhibit will be installed in the aquarium proper through April 26, 2009, and is included with admission to the facility.
